

Financial Assistance offered by SBADV

Please submit your requests to our chapter.

SBADV provides financial assistance in the following categories. Requests for reimbursement for medical expenses must include documentation that the expense is not covered by insurance or that the request submitted is for the individual's co-pay amount. There is a yearly maximum for each fund, but the total yearly amount available to each individual with Spina Bifida is capped at \$1,500.00. The Association's fiscal year is January to December. Requests for reimbursement must be received by March 15 of the year following the date of the incurred expense.

Direct Patient Aid provides up to \$1,500.00 for medical bills related to Spina Bifida but not covered by the Incontinence or Equipment Funds.

Equipment Fund provides up to \$1,500.00 per year for the purchase of wheelchairs, crutches, braces, and other adaptive devices.

Incontinence Fund provides up to \$1,000.00 a year for uncovered incontinence supplies.

Post-Secondary Education provides up to \$1,500.00 for expenses related to attending college, trade school or other specialized training to gain employment.

Campership Fund provides financial aid for adults and children to attend camp or other group activities during the summer for socialization. Maximums are determined yearly by the Board based on the amount budgeted for the fund and the number of individuals requesting funds.

National Event Fund provides assistance of up to \$500.00 to individuals who qualify for participation in a national-level sports, academic or talent competition.

Driver's Education Fund provides one-time funding of up to \$500.00 for behind-the-wheel driver's education training.

Conference Assistance provides funding to cover conference registration and up to \$550.00 (or an amount determined by the Board of Directors) for expenses related to attendance at SBA's Regional Conferences. Reimbursement amounts for attendance at SBA-sponsored Educations Days will vary due to location and are determined by the Board.
