Champion of the Community

The Spina Bifida Association of Delaware Valley has awarded Jeanne Melchionni with the Champion of the Community Award. Jeanne Melchionni has been a lifelong advocate for those living with Spina Bifida. She has been a dedicated and passionate champion to the CHOP community for the past 42 years. When Jeanne began her employment with the Spina Bifida clinic, Jeanne worked with Dr. Mary Ames, who, in 1964, started the first Spina Bifida Program in the country. THE FIRST! At the time, Jeanne and Mary had only about 150 patients. CHOP's Spina Bifida program has now expanded to over 550 patients of all ages and nationalities.


Currently, Jeanne is the coordinator of the clinic and is working on beginning a multidisciplinary program for adults at Penn using the CHOP Program as a model.

Jeanne was awarded The Caroline Langstadter Award for Excellence in Nursing at CHOP in 1995 and the even-closer-to-her-heart "Forget Me Not" award from the Spina Bifida Association of Delaware Valley.

She has been a part of numerous publications over the years in which she has collaborated with many colleagues in all divisions of Children's Hospital. These articles and essays have aided in advancing the care of our kids for the future.

The Herman family stated, "Jeanne has been a constant in our lives ever since my son's birth in 2016. She has always greeted my family to the clinic with a warm, welcoming smile. When I have questions about what to do with Finn, she's quick to email me back and give sage advice. But, mostly, Jeanne is THERE for us in both our triumphs and failures. She celebrates our victories and holds us up in our defeats. She is a constant, someone who has dedicated her life to helping others, and, ultimately, seeing the divine essence in every single human being."
